Be provided a training environment on a regular basis that includes golf coaching, strength and conditioning, sport education and a medical network.</p> <p><u>How do I get selected?</u> Applications are submitted by interested candidates based on selection criteria detailed below. The program will introduce these players to professional coaching and an opportunity to mix with current members of the BSA Squad.</p> <p><u>How do I get selected?</u> The squad is selected by the SWGA Junior Coordinator in conjunction with SWGA Junior committee.</p> <p><u>Selection criteria</u> Selection is based on attitude, participation in Order of Merit events, feedback from coaches, dedication and commitment to improving their game.</p> <p><u>What does it entail?</u> 7 x 2hr Training sessions with BSA Coaches Scott Smith & Gary Attrill</p> <p><u>Cost</u> No cost and all squad members receive a polo shirt</p>



<p style="text-align: center;">Golf Geelong Junior Order of Merit</p>	<p><u>Purpose</u> Introduces up and coming Junior Golfers to tournament golf in the local area and gain experience playing away from their home club.</p> <p><u>Who is eligible</u> All local golfers under the age of 18, is a financial member of a SWGA Club and holds an official Australian handicap.</p> <p><u>What is involved</u> There are 12 tournaments over the course of the year from which participants accrue points based on their gross and nett scores</p> <p><u>What is the cost</u> Tournament entry fees are typically between \$15-\$25</p>
