

Barwon Sports Academy – Anti Doping Policy

Illegal drug use in sport is a social, health and legal problem that needs to be addressed in accordance with protocols established between Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority [ASADA], State Sporting Bodies and the Victorian Police Force.

As a Regional Sports Academy the BSA is governed by State and National bodies and it is a requirement that all athletes have a thorough understanding of ASADA and drugs in sport.

The BSA policy around ASADA/drugs in sport is currently being developed.

BSA ASADA Anti Doping Requirements for Athletes in 2016

- 1. Compulsory attendance at ASADA Drugs in Sport Education Session
- 2. Completion of Online Level 1 Course and provision of certificate of completion to BSA office
