



Barwon Sports Academy – Anti Doping Policy

Illegal drug use in sport is a social, health and legal problem that needs to be addressed in accordance with protocols established between Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority [ASADA], State Sporting Bodies and the Victorian Police Force.

As a Regional Sports Academy the BSA is governed by State and National bodies and it is a requirement that all athletes have a thorough understanding of ASADA and drugs in sport.

The BSA policy around ASADA/drugs in sport is currently being developed.

BSA ASADA Anti Doping Requirements for Athletes in 2016

1. Compulsory attendance at ASADA Drugs in Sport Education Session
2. Completion of Online Level 1 Course and provision of certificate of completion to BSA office
